International Opportunities

Thinking about studying abroad?

- The Erasmus+:
 - **for Studies**: allows students to spend a period of study (between 2 and 12 months) at one of the other 500 universities in any of the participating European countries
 - **for traineeship**: allows to carry out an internship at a foreign company. The internships are aimed at students enrolled in a university course and who are close to the graduation. They typically are used as master thesis but can be carried out up to 12 months after graduation
- Ulisse Program: for mobilities to non-European countries outside the Erasmus+ framework
- SEMP: Swiss European Mobility Program
- DECAMP: virtual mobility
- BIP: Blended Intensive Programmes
- Double Degree programs

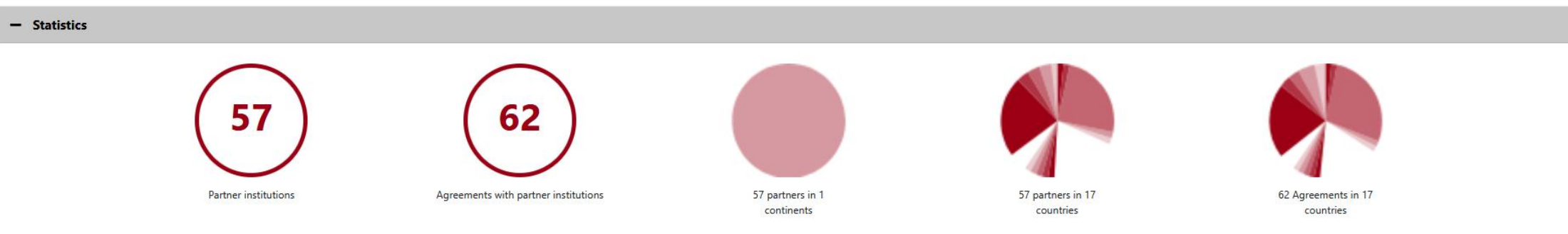
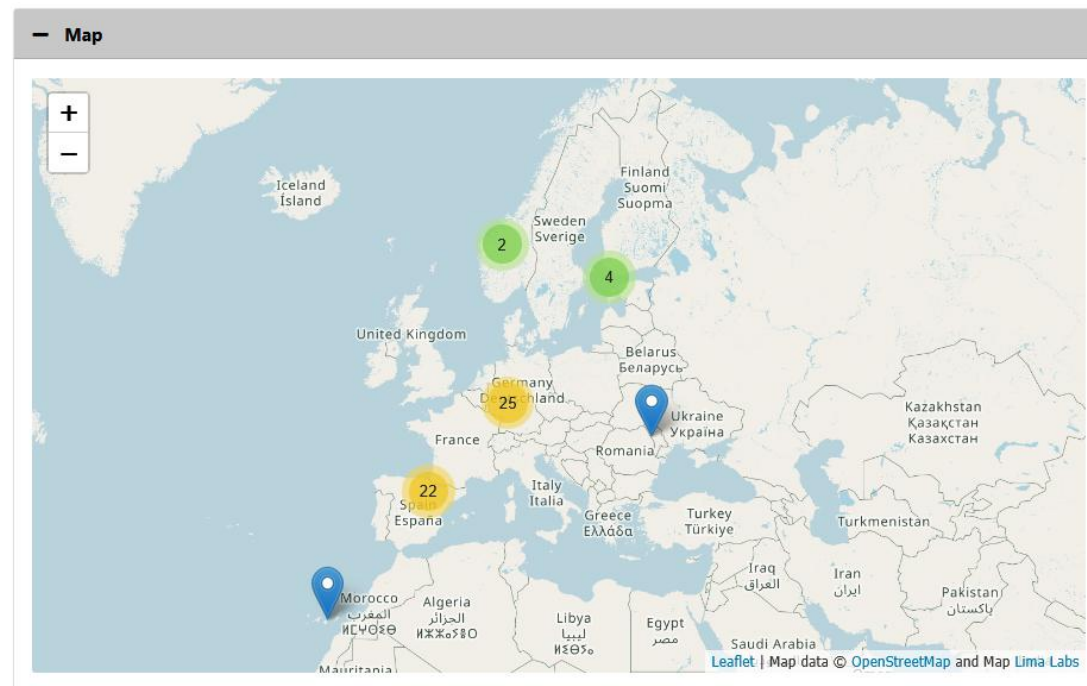

Erasmus+ for studies: Overall ranking

- The ranking is the sum of two contributions:
 - GPA (out of 30 points)
 - "Time productivity" (out of 30 credits)



Erasmus+ for studies: Choose your destination

- Tier A: DTU, UPC Barcelona
- Tier B: Madrid, Dresden, Aachen, Midsweden, Alpen-Adria Klagenfurt
- Tier C: Other Spanish destinations, Darmstadt, Coimbra, Aveiro
- Tier D: France (e.g., Rennes, Saint-Etienne, Grenoble)
- Tier E: Destinations where the coordinator is not an ICT professor



Erasmus+ for studies: Tier A

- Very difficult to get in
 - Suggestion: select Tier A destination only if you have a high ranking
 - Possibly consider a backup
- Example
 - Denmarks Tekniske Universitet (Technical University of Denmark)

- Good backup choices
- Example

Erasmus+ for studies: Tier C

- Courses are not always taught in English: better check what they offer and the course teaching language
- Still, plenty of nice destinations
- Consider these (at least as backups) if your ranking is not high or if you know the local language
- Very hard not to be admitted there
- Example

Erasmus+ for studies: Tier D

- Courses are NOT taught in English
- Yet, very good destinations
- Consider these only:
 - if you know the local language
 - or you plan to go there for your thesis

Erasmus+ for studies: Tier E

- High probability to get lower priority than students from other degrees
- In some cases, this risk is 100% guaranteed (check the constraints!)
- It is better to contact the professor
- Example

 - multiple flows (for ICT and non-ICT)

Erasmus+ for studies: Choose your destination

- When you make your choice remember that:
 - Each destination has a limited number of positions (typically 2)
 - Everybody wants to apply to Tier A or B so there are few chances to be accepted even with high ranking
 - You might want to coordinate among yourselves



After you are Accepted

- You have to fill in the Learning Agreement
- Rule 1: be curious!
- Rule 2: carefully read the instructions!!
- Rule 3: ask for clarifications if you have any doubt!!!

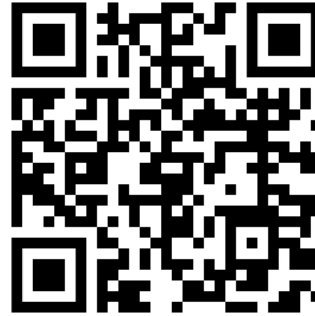

SEMP - Swiss European Mobility Programme

- Following the popular referendum results against mass migration on 9 February 2014, the European Union and Swiss authorities decided to suspend negotiations on the participation of Switzerland in Erasmus+
- Switzerland cannot join any student and teaching staff mobility actions under the Erasmus+ Program
- As a temporary alternative, the Swiss European Mobility Program (SEMP) was launched, and the University of Padova has joined it with ad hoc agreements to allow student mobility from Padova to Swiss Universities

Ulisse

- Ulisse is a student mobility program towards countries not in the European Union
- There are destinations in 4 continents: Europe, America, Asia and Oceania
- The mobility period can last **from 3 to 12 months** (depending on the chosen destination)
- Scholarships available for selected destinations (check the call!!)

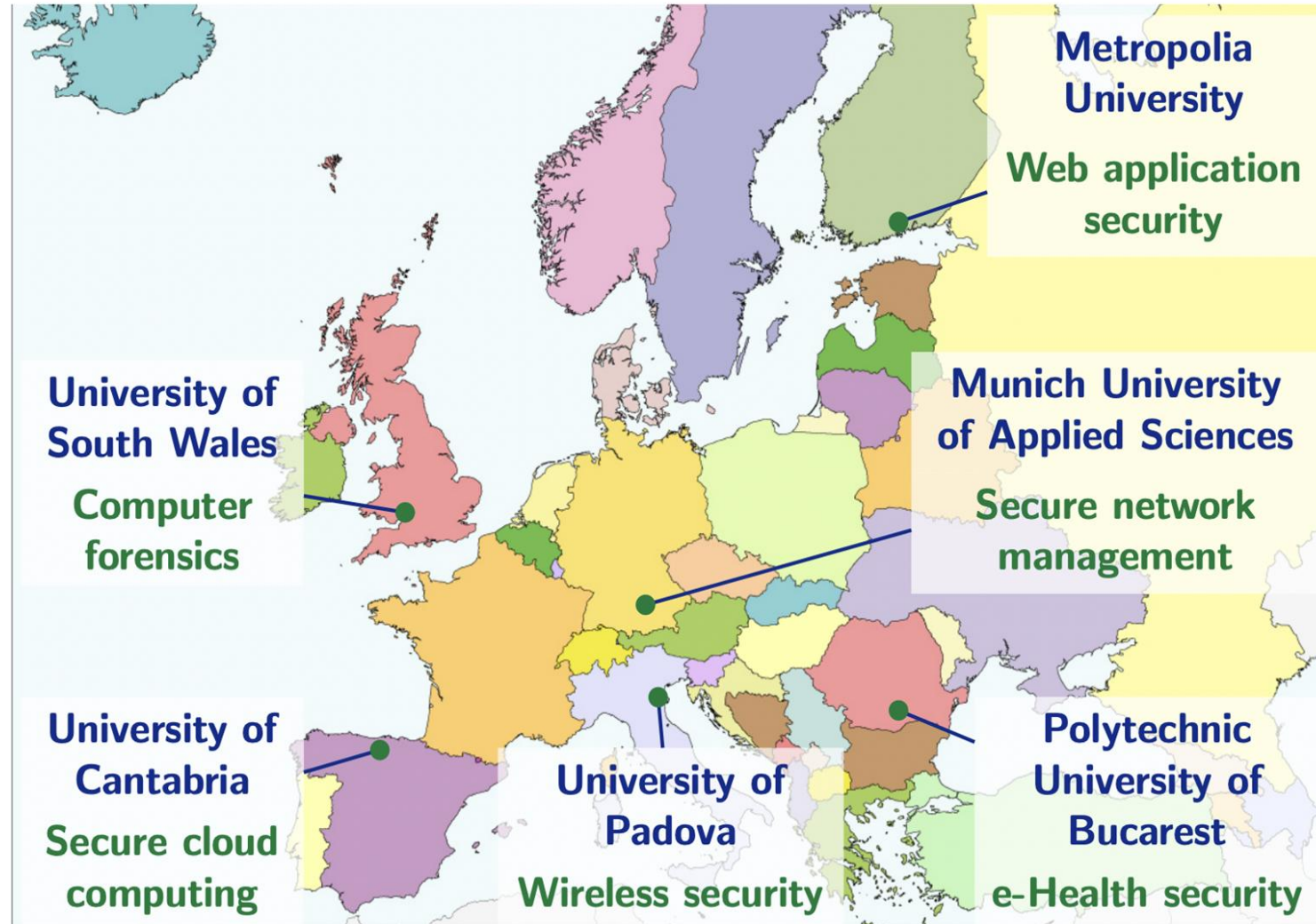

Decamp Virtual Mobility

BIP

- Blended Intensive Programmes (BIP) are a new funding scheme under the Erasmus+ Program
- BIP are international learning activities combining online collaboration and a short physical mobility, designed around a “challenge-based” approach
- Minimum 3 ECTS must be awarded under this kind of programs, and the involvement of at least 3 European universities is required



Deadlines and Contacts

Application timeframe on Uniweb

- First Call: 20 May 2025 – 3 June 2025, 1 p.m.
- Second Call: 23 September 2025 – 7 October 2025, 1 p.m.
- Third Call: 25 November 2025 – 9 December 2025, 1 p.m.
- Fourth Call: 20 January 2026 – 10 February 2026, 1 p.m.
- Fifth Call: 03 March 2026 – 17 March 2026, 1 p.m.
- Sixth Call: 21 April 2026 – 5 May 2026, 1 p.m.

Double Degrees

- Students that participate to double degrees spend:
 - One year at UNIPD
 - One year at the exchange university
- All involved students get two degrees from both universities
- Scholarships are awarded for moving students (similar to the Erasmus+ but higher)
- Admission to the program is regulated by a selection at the end of the first semester of the 1st year
- Admission criteria based on merit: ECTS credits already gained and average grades
- Admission is ultimately subject to fulfillment of 1st year requirements in UNIPD

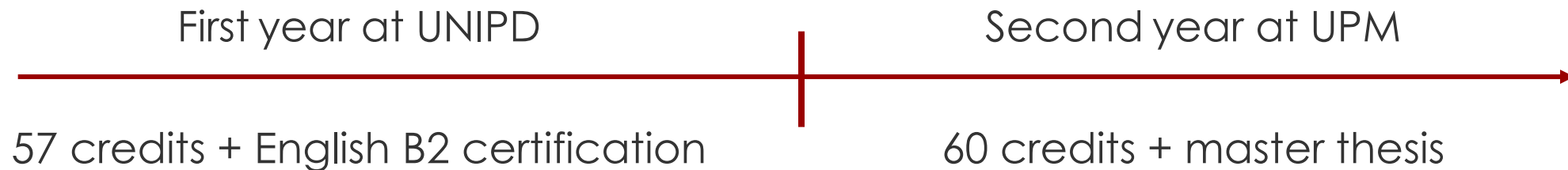
Double Degree with UPM - ETSIT

- UPM is one of the top technical universities in Spain
- The Máster Universitario of UPM is also giving access to the board of Engineers (in Spain)
- The department of ETSIT-UPM involves four research areas: Comunicación, Telématica, Optoelectronica, Biomédica
- They have 13 double degree programs and countless Erasmus+ programs, the environment is quite international: Many courses are taught in English
- The collaboration agreement involves:
 - Master degree in ICT for Internet and multimedia
 - Máster Universitario in Ingeniería de Telecomunicación of the Universidad Politécnica de Madrid, Escuela Técnica Superior de Ingenieros de Telecomunicación



Double Degree with UPM - ETSIT

- The full amount of the ECTS credits undertaken by students participating to the exchange is 150, of which:
 - 57+3* credits correspond to the first year in Padova
 - 60 credits are the mandatory subjects of the degree at UPM
 - 30 credits are the master thesis (at UPM)
- * Students are admitted only if they completed the first year: this must also include the English B2 certification (3 ECTS)



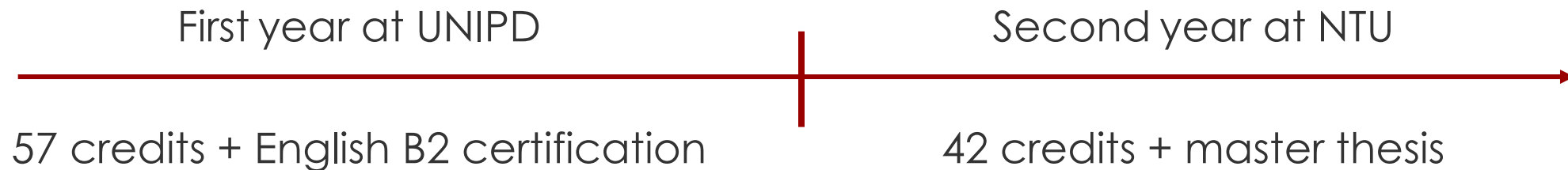
Double Degree with NTU

- NTU is considered the best university of Taiwan
- International programs are relatively limited, but students from Europe usually are very welcome!
- Interactions with the thesis supervisors (assigned on the very first day) are frequent
- There is a significant offer of courses taught in English. They also offer opportunities to blend in the Chinese culture.
- The agreement involves:
 - UNIPD Master degree in ICT for Internet and multimedia
 - NTU Master degree in Communication Engineering



Double Degree with NTU

- The full amount of the ECTS credits undertaken by students participating to the exchange is 132, of which:
 - 57+3* credits correspond to the first year in Padova
 - 42 credits correspond to the second year at NTU
 - 30 credits are the master thesis at NTU
- * Students are admitted only if they completed the first year: this must also include the English B2 certification (3 ECTS)



Deadlines

- Deadline to apply to the program: February 2026 (dates to be announced)
- Notifications of acceptance: February 2026 (dates to be announced)
- If you applied for other international calls, such as Erasmus+, you must choose!

Double Degree - More info

- You can submit your application to mime@dei.unipd.it with:
 - your student data (name, student number, enrolment year)
 - marks achieved during your MS degree - self-certified
 - any other relevant information (e.g. language proficiencies)
 - your choice of destinations - if both, specify priority
